

RESOLUTION 2018-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF YANKEETOWN, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING USAGE FEES FOR YANKEETOWN PARKS AND FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, The Town of Yankeetown has determined that providing for recreational parks and boating for its residents and general public make significant contributions to Yankeetown's economy and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Yankeetown realizes the need to provide well maintained parks and facilities for the enjoyment of its residents and general public; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Yankeetown has determined that in order to maintain these parks and facilities a usage fee should be established; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Yankeetown may by Resolution set appropriate fees for any of the Towns parks or facilities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Yankeetown, Florida, in Regular Session on the 2nd Day of April 2018:

1. The following usage fees shall be amended and imposed for the following Town of Yankeetown parks and facilities:
 - a.) **Winding River Park - Non-Residents:**
Daily Fee shall be \$30.00
 - b.) **Yacht Basin Boat Ramp - Non-Residents:**
Daily Fee shall be \$5.00
Yearly Fee shall be \$20.00 prorated quarterly for Inglis Residents
Yearly Fee shall be \$40.00 prorated quarterly for all other Residents
(Daily Fees will be place in drop box near ramp. Those that pay a Yearly Fee will be issued a vehicle hangtag)
 - c.) **Withlacochee Gulf Preserve (WGP) - Residents and Non-Residents:**
Daily Fee shall be \$50.00 - Events on Park Grounds
Daily Fee shall be \$250.00 - Educational Center / 1st Floor Conference Room
Daily Fee shall be \$75.00 - Educational Center / Ground Floor Screened Room
2.
 - a.) For all Town Parks, except the Withlacochee Gulf Preserve, for Public and Private Educational Facilities there are no fees.
 - b.) For the Withlacochee Gulf Preserve, fees shall be applicable except for organizations and events which further the mission of the WGP which shall be exempt from fees.
 - c.) The Board of Trustees can waive fees for the WGP at their discretion.
3. The Yankeetown Town Council can waive fees for any of the Town Parks at their discretion.
4. This Resolution shall repeal all prior Resolutions inconsistent or in conflict.
